

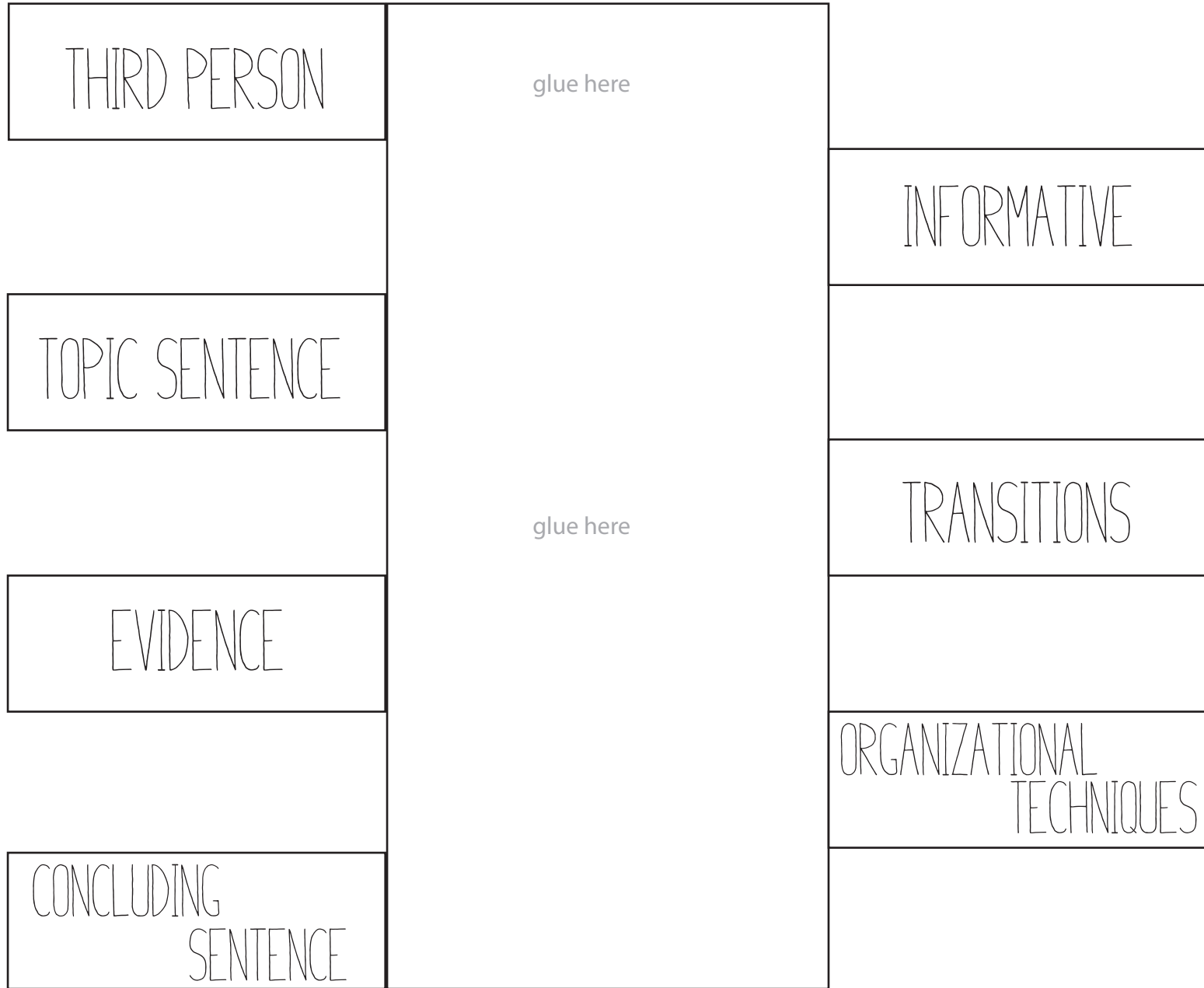
Argumentative Writing

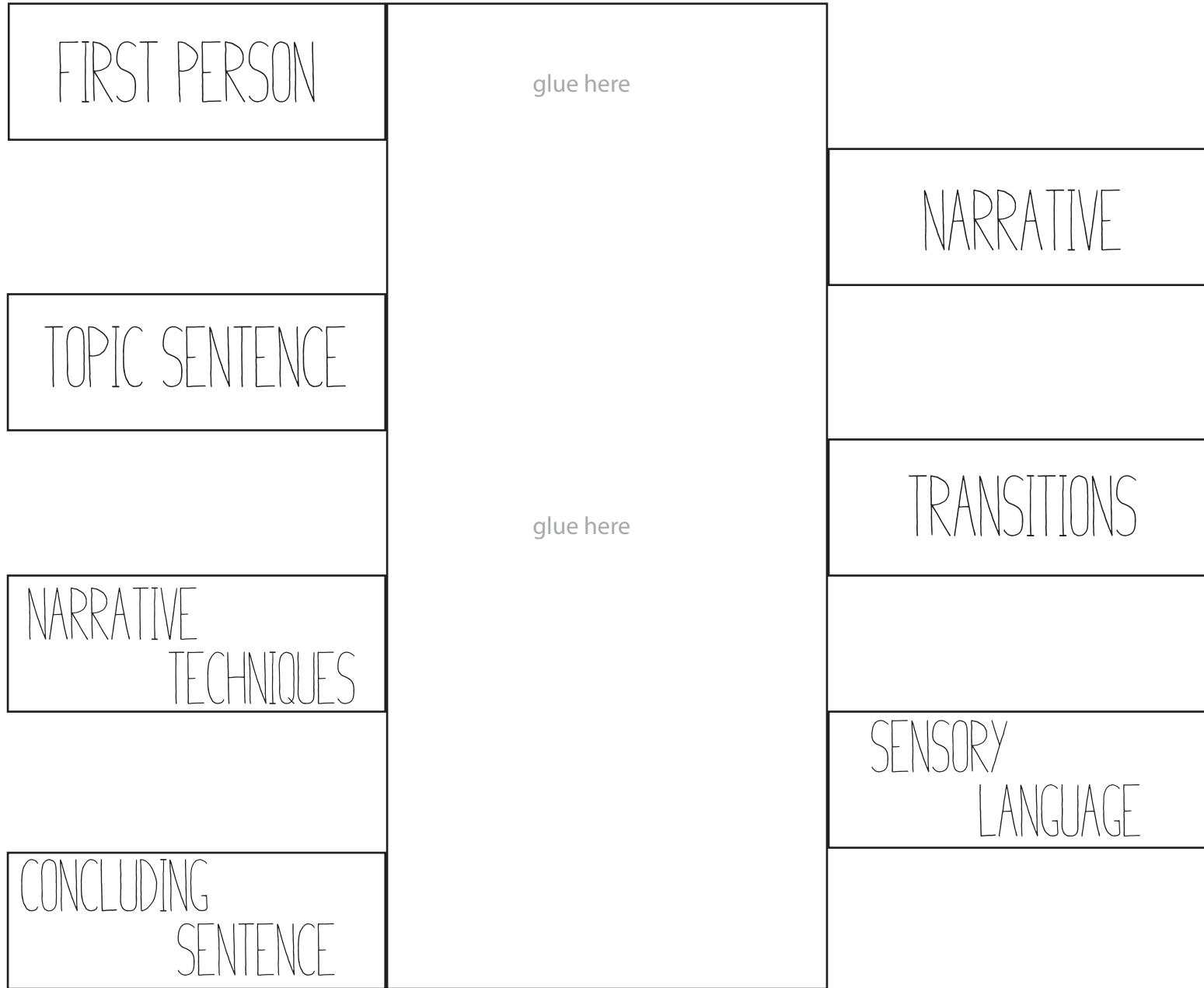
Informative Writing
