PURPOSE:

Grammar can be interactive, and when students handle the preposition pieces, they are engaging with the material in a hands-on way.

Our finished preposition boxes serve as a reminder of our activities. As students advance with their understanding of prepositions, they can add prepositional phrases to the box too.

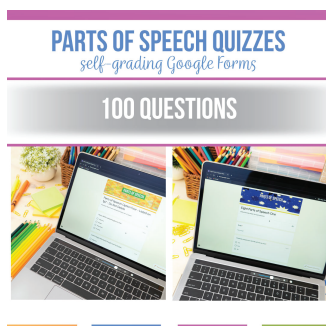
IDEAS FOR IMPLEMENTATION:

Print the pieces and cut them. I grab a box (any object will work) and some tape. Students practice location of the preposition with the box.

Line up the slips of paper on the left side of a large piece of poster board. Students then complete the phrases. If they don't tape the prepositions to the poster board, we have fun rearranging the prepositions and making silly phrases.

Laminate the prepositions. As a fun activity, I will hand a preposition to each student and ask them to create a phrase or a sentence that includes the preposition. Since the pieces are laminated, students can easily exchange them.
